All Students

- 1 USB/flash/jump drive - 1GB (label with name)
- 2 boxes Kleenex (give to advisor)
- 2 containers anti-bacterial wipes (give to advisor)
- 1 pack markers (keep in locker)
- 1 glue stick (keep in locker)
- Access to internet and word-processing software at home for research and homework
- Library card from local public library (Rivermont students use the Bettendorf Public Library which honors library cards issues by other Quad City libraries)

Grade 6

Grade 7

- Individual notebooks (perforated & college-rule): Drama, English, French/Spanish, Health, Latin, Science, Social Studies, YAL (*Please note that students need a separate notebook for each subject as teachers collect notebooks from students.*)
- pencils (ample supply)
- pens: blue or black (ample supply)
- calculator for math & science

Grade 8

- 3-ring binder: English
- Individual folders with pockets: Drama, English, Health, Spanish, YAL, History
- notebook (perforated): Drama, French/Spanish, Health, Latin, Science, YAL, History (*Please note that students need a separate notebook for each subject as teachers collect notebooks from students.*)
