

Scrip Frequently Asked Questions

What is Scrip?

Scrip is certificates or gift cards from stores and restaurants that are used just like cash. When you buy a gift card through Scrip, you receive the face value of that gift card to use for a purchase of goods or services from a retailer.

How does Scrip raise money for Rivermont Parents' Council?

Rivermont purchases Scrip at a discount through a national network. The discounts typically range from 3% to 15% of its value. Parents' Council then sells the gift cards or certificates at face value to our school families and friends. You never pay more than face value, so it doesn't cost anything extra to purchase Scrip.

Which stores participate in Scrip?

Scrip is available for local grocery stores, many restaurants, home improvement stores, department stores and mall retailers. In short, hundreds of local and national retailers participate in Scrip. Many are listed on our paper order form, but others are also available. To see a complete list, go to www.glscrip.com. If you see something you'd like to order that's not on our order form, just write it in.

How do I order Scrip?

Scrip order forms are sent home periodically throughout the year in paper form. They are also available at the Welcome Desk in Central Hall and in the mansion foyer. Online order forms are sent home monthly. Orders received by the end of the day on any Friday will be distributed no later than the following Friday. Just send the order form and your check in with your child in an envelope marked Parents' Council.

The key to success of Scrip is increased participation! Every school family buys food, gas and other needed items – every family could use Scrip for these purchases.
